NEW Parking Rules & Fees

Please note that there is now a **FEE** for Visitor's Parking (2nd floor, UConn-Stamford garage), which can be accessed through this website: <http://park.uconn.edu/paybyphone-mobile-parking-payments/>. Please follow all instructions in order to correctly pay for parking. (Note that there only 6 parking coin meters on this floor, which have a limit of 3 hours.) **PayByPhone Parking** is an easy-to-use mobile parking payment option: park in a PayByPhone space; enter

the location number, your license plate number & anticipated time into the mobile app. That's it! **If you don't have a smartphone** sign up ahead of time at paybyphone.com and then **call the toll-free number posted in the location** to start your parking session. The app is free but you do need to sign up for the service. You will need to provide the license plate number(s) of your vehicle(s) and credit card information during the sign-up process. **The parking fee at the UConn-Stamford garage is \$1/hour (until 5 PM).**
